### **VALUE OF OUR SERVICES:**

In **2017**, **518 volunteers** invested **7,166 hours** and completed home repairs and modifications worth a market value of **\$239,582** for Northland residents.

### **FOLLOW-UP SURVEY RESULTS OF OUR SAFE AT HOME PROGRAM:**

2015 clients fell **62** times before our modifications, and only **2** times after our modifications.

2016 clients fell **94** times before our modifications, and only **4** times after our modifications.
